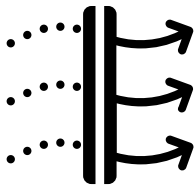
Dryer Care & Maintenance Helpful Guide

Whether you have a dryer, blaster, or combination, regularly caring for this equipment is crucial to keep it performing at its best, prolonging the life of its motor and preventing expensive damage from occurring.



Daily Checks

- Check the power cable & plug for any nicks, splits or damage
- Check casing for cracks, hair build-up or damage
- Check filters are clean and clear of debris before operating
- Check dryer hose for splits or damage
- Check carbon brushes for wear*



Filter cleaning

- Ensuring the dryer is turned off and unplugged; remove filter from dryer and clear of hair and debris, you can use a vacuum to clear the filter
- Wash thoroughly with warm water
- Leave to dry completely before reinserting into the dryer
- Check manufacturers guide to see if there are multiple filters that require cleaning
- Never use your dryer or blaster without the filter



Professional Servicing*

- Take your dryer for servicing at least once a year, ideally once every 6 months if heavily used
- Check the specification of your dryer for runtime before servicing to keep your dryer in its best condition
- Servicing replaces filters, carbon brushes and any other necessary wear and tear items and strips down the dryer to be thoroughly cleared of hair, fur, dirt, carbon and other particles



Warning Signs

If your dryer does any of the following, it is advisable to stop using it and book in for a service/repair.

- Inconsistent power
- No power at all
- Performance issues, particularly at start up or high speeds
- Burning smell
- Carbon brushes need to be replaced when they get down to ¼ of their original size, or ¼ inch in length
